



Important notice regarding Sage 100 Payroll subscriptions

It has come to our attention that several customers are using a version of Sage 100 Payroll that utilizes TLS 1.0, an aging technology that may expose their data to significant security risks (See the [Security Risks with older versions of TLS](#)). Because of these risks, Sage is deprecating the older versions of this technology effective June 15, 2020.

Effective June 15, 2020, Sage 100 Payroll tax calculation engines using TLS 1.0 will no longer function. To avoid disruption, Sage partners will need to upgrade their customers to at least 2.19.0 prior to June 15, 2020. As a prerequisite, Sage 100 installations must be upgraded to at least Sage 100 2018 Product Update 3.

On May 11, 2020, affected customers will receive an email from Sage informing them of the need to upgrade.
